- No Brown Sticker conventions allowed

December 4th and 5th:

• The Victor Champion Cup Swiss Teams

- Playoff Points for 1st, 2nd and 3rd awarded at half rate as approved by the ABF
- Entry fee: 240 credits per Team

- 2 sessions per day starting at 11am and 3pm (TBC)

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Persons applying to enter the Victor Champion Cup events should be aware of the following:

- 1. The Regulating Authority (The Australian Bridge Federation) reserves the right to refuse admission to any player who is not in good standing with any registered bridge club, bridge association or the Regulating Authority.
- 2. No entry for an event will be regarded as complete unless the entry has been submitted before the closing date as specified on page 2 of this brochure, with full entry fees paid and ABF numbers supplied. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser.
- 3. All players living in Australia must be current financial members of the ABF Masterpoint Scheme and registered with MyABF.
- 4. Players born on or after 1/1/1996 receive a 50% discount on their entry fees to all events at the Victor Champion Cup.
- 5. All session times in this brochure are provisional and may be altered by the organisers as necessary to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the responsibility of players to be aware of the starting times of the sessions and rounds as posted by the Director.
- 6. Systems permitted in the various events are determined in accordance with the ABF Tournament Regulations.
- 7. All players must have working video and audio connections. Players may only turn off their camera with the permission of the Director.
