# Congress Venue: The Village Green Hotel (Cabaret Room)

The Cabaret Room in 'The Village' will turn into our bridge players den for 4 exciting days. This venue ticks so many boxes; great location, HEAPS of parking right at the door, break out spaces, café to purchase from, and the sports bar is a great place to watch the footy. It's also a gaming venue which presents a couple of small hurdles. When you arrive, the only entrance to the building that you will be able to come through is the one directly at our playing area (where you would want to come in anyway). The playing area is around the back, essentially diagonally opposite the intersection of Springvale and Ferntree Gully Roads (but at the rear). The more challenging hurdle is coffee! Don't panic, instant coffee is available all day, every day and barista made coffee is available after 10am. If you can't handle starting the day without an espresso, please make sure that you grab one before you get to the venue.

Entries will then be divided into 10 pair (5 table) segments. You will then challenge the other 9 pairs to vie for top place in your division.

At the top end of the field, the event offers prestige competing to be the best of the best. As the divisions move to less experienced segments, players can feel at home competing against players of a similar level.

This event will be conducted as a barometer (all pairs in your section play the same boards at the same time) and live scores will be available after each round. If you have ever played the Gold Coast Pairs Finals, it will be a similar progression.

Hands from the graded pairs will also be written up with expert analysis to take home and enjoy.

Don't waste away the morning just because it's Grand Final Day, come enjoy the Graded Pairs! The event will conclude with plenty of time to watch the big game (or to play more bridge:D)
